Dear Friends,

It is with great joy that we look back on the past year and the growth of Clever Kids in many aspects and the academic success of the students at school. A milestone has been reached. The first of our learners have reached grade 12 and have successfully graduated, some even with many distinctions.

We are very delighted that we were able to rent the neighbouring building to accommodate the increasing number of 67 children. It has been almost a year since we were able to move into our second house. It is such a blessing to be able to use these beautiful rooms. Having enough space makes teaching and homework supervision so much easier.

The impact of disrupted education since the COVID 19 outbreak has been devastating, especially with learners from disadvantaged communities in South Africa. They are between 75% and a full school year behind where they should be, according to latest statistics. We have really felt the effects of this over the past year. The children worked hard to catch up on the content they had not covered during this time.

Thanks to our computer lab in the new building, we can offer the children an additional tool for learning. A subscription to an online learning programme in Math and English is an excellent way to identify and close gaps and prepare for testing. The rush of desperate parents who want to register their children with us and the long waiting list for children who are keen to join Clever Kids shows us the demand and relevance of our work to support students in their academic studies. We will continue to do our best in the coming year, to serve the children of the community in Masiphumelele.

THANK you so very much to all our donors for your loyal and valuable support over this last year. Thanks to your support, we have not only been able to help the children with their school education, but also to clothe them, satisfy their hunger, buy school uniforms, support them in crisis situations and give them a very special treat with excursions and birthday parties. Your help means a great deal to the children and the staff and we greatly appreciate it.

And finally, I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to our hard-working and dedicated employees, teachers and volunteers. We're so grateful to have an amazing team like you who allow our program to run so effectively. When Grade 1 students join us, they often lack foundational skills of holding pencils correctly, struggle with their alphabet and numbers. Our tutors focus on filling in these learning gaps, emphasising confidence and proficiency in English and Math. Grade 4 students face the challenge of adapting to English textbooks for their additional subjects for the first time, and we take pride in their dedication and the support provided by our outstanding tutors.

Having fun together is a great way to build relationships. We often play games, dance, skip and make some crafts. Learning should be fun, so we always encourage educational play.

Education in South Africa, especially in places like Masiphumelele, can be a bit of a struggle with limited resources and infrastructure, and not enough teachers. Clever Kids aims to make life a bit easier for the primary and high school students with providing a safe learning space for tutoring and homework support. Clever Kids helps the high school students get a grip on those tough subjects, like Math and Science.

But it's not just about playing catch-up. These extra lessons give students a more personal touch, something regular classrooms often miss. Clever Kids steps in with smaller groups and more attention, boosting confidence and motivation.

Clever Kids students have done so well at Masiphumelele High School in 2022. They received numerous academic awards in subjects considered difficult, such as Mathematics and Physical Sciences. Teachers at nearby schools where our students attend frequently encourage their pupils to join Clever Kids as they can see its fruit.

We are so proud of the high school students for their determination and perseverance.









Outings


